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OUR MARICOPA STORY

Since opening our first Maricopa Club at Santa Cruz Elementary School in August 2020, Boys & Girls Clubs of the Sun Corridor has grown alongside our community. Through our partnership with Maricopa Unified School District, we now serve youth from all seven MUSD elementary schools and three middle schools.

This year marks an exciting new chapter as our program expands to Alma Farrell Innovation Academy, allowing us to serve middle school youth for the first time. We now proudly provide programs for students in grades K–8, creating more opportunities for youth to stay engaged and supported.

Today, we serve approximately 175 Club Members each day through before- and after-school programs, school break camps, and summer programs. As Maricopa grows, so does our commitment to helping every young person build a Great Future.
